WATER RESTRICTIONS



All residents should be aware that stage 2 water restrictions come into force on December 10.

Gardens can only be watered before 10am or after 4pm with a **watering can** or bucket and the use of unattended hoses is no longer permitted. Cars can only be washed with a bucket or at a commercial car wash.

Heavy fines apply for the use of water outside of authorized use. Sydney Water encourages all of us to conserve water use wherever possible, as we move into the hotter and drier part of the year.

2020 PREMIER'S GALA CONCERT DARLING HARBOUR

Good news! The Cotswolds Village has been successful in securing 20 tickets to the 2020 NSW Premier's Gala Concert at Darling Harbour. This year the concert is being held early on Friday 14th February. Last year 18 residents enjoyed this concert performed by popular talented artists.

Family and Community Services has arranged free bus transport for our group to and from the concert. The bus will collect residents at 9.30am returning at 2pm. The concert runs for approximately 1 hour and 30 mins including a short intermission.

Residents are requested to bring a water bottle and packed lunch.

There will be Sydney Water refilling stations available on the day.

There is no charge for tickets and transport, but there must be a commitment to attend on the day if you are allocated a ticket.

We must return any unwanted tickets so they can be reallocated.
